

| Definition of Clinical/Practical Skill Domains |  |  |

| Domain   | Definition   |  |
| Data-Gathering Skills                          | Defined as: the candidates' ability to obtain and identify important information, correlate the clinical data to recommend appropriate testing. It includes interviewing and history taking.   |  |
| Reasoning and Analytical Skills                | Defined as: the candidates' ability to rationalize recommended effective<br>management plans, evaluate alternative plans, recognize indicators to<br>different appropriate treatments based on relevant, correct clinical data<br>interpterion.  |  |
| Decision-Making Skills                         | Defined as: the candidates' ability to formulate a logical diagnosis, identify<br>immediate needs, and make accurate inferences regarding the expected<br>outcomes. It includes recognizing potential complications, risks, and benefits.  |  |
| Professional Attitude                          | Defined as the commitment to deliver the highest standards of ethical and<br>professional behavior in all aspects of health practice.<br>Attitudes, knowledge, and skills based on clinical &/or medical administrative<br>competence, ethics, societal, & legal duties resulting in the wise application of<br>behaviors that demonstrate a commitment to excellence, respect, integrity,<br>accountability & altruism (e.g. self-awareness, reflection, life-long learning,<br>scholarly habits, & physician health for sustainable practice). |  |
